2015 Annual General Meeting

The Specimen Fish recommendations were all approved along with the following club proposals.

Tintagel SAC - That reasonable out of pocket expenses are paid to the CFSA Conservation and Fisheries Protection Committee members in order for them to carry out their duties on behalf of of CFSA members.

St Columb SAC - Regarding CFSA A.G.M. Which is held on Saturday afternoons the proposal is to change the meeting to an evening time, example: Monday or Tuesday evening.

Grenville arms SAC - £2 levy to be paid by each member of the CFSA to help the Conservation/lobbying fund with their pursuit to stop inshore netting.

Redruth SAA - The AGM shall be held no later than the end of December in each year. At least 28 days prior notice in writing shall be sent to al persons and clubs asn defined under rule 4

Redruth SAA - Any rule that is new or amended and passwed at either an AGM or EGM will be implemented from the 1st of the month following the meeting apart from the Specimen Fish recommendations which take effect in 2015, the other rules passed will come into effect in 2016

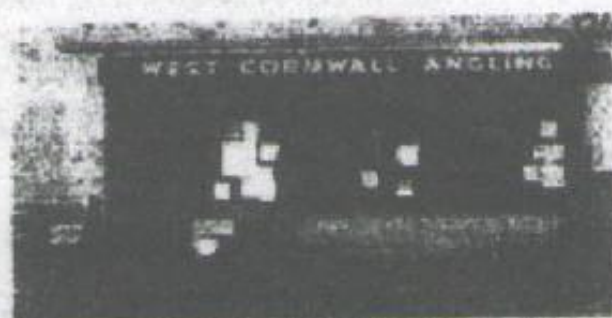

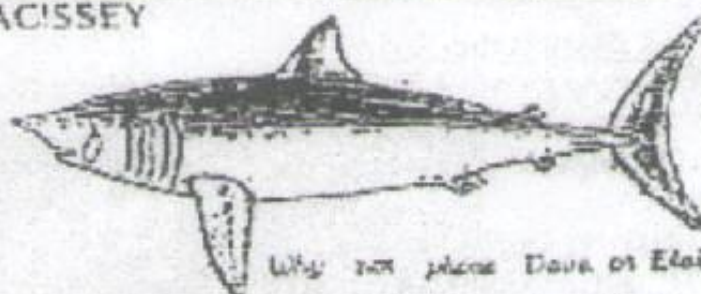
