Camborne AA V Mounts Bay AS 60th Tre -Pol-Pen Competition

The first leg was fished on Sunday 17th May with the CAA recording 697.349% and the MBAS recording 739.783%, a lead of 41.783% for the MBAS to take into the second leg fished on Sunday 4th July.

On the day the MBAS recorded 1075.16% and the CAA recorded 1009.295%

Overall winners were the MBAS by a margin of 107.594%, thus winning back the Tre-Pol-Pen Trophy.

Bass Regulations

A new European regulation was introduced on the 25th March 2015 which means that people fishing for Bass in England and Wales shall not retain more than Three specimens of Bass per day (00.00hrs to 23.59hrs)

Please also note that the minimum size for keeping Bass will be increased from the 1st September to 42cm.

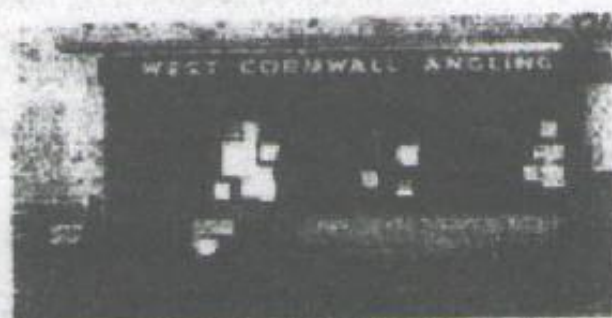
