RULES & AGENDA

EFSA England Species Festival (Bream) Weymouth 17th & 18th October 2015

Competitor Number

1. The championship will be fished to the EFSA rules governing at the time unless otherwise stated.
2. H.Q. will be the Weymouth Angling Society.
3. A draw for boat allocation takes place prior to the competition. Boat positions will be drawn on the day.
4. A Fishing Captain and Steward will be appointed for each boat and their duties will involve:
 - a. Liaison with the boat skipper.
 - B. Ensuring the Festival rules are adhered to.
 - c. Observance of start and finish times.
 - d. To ensure the boat sheet is completed, signed and returned to the Score Marshall.
 - e. To assist and adjudicate with the measuring and recording of fish.
5. The fishing areas will be designated by the Organizing Committee.
6. If in the opinion of the Organizing Committee, the weather is unfit to allow the boats to reach the normal Fishing grounds, the Committee has the power to abandon the day's fishing or to limit the boats to a safe Haven. Their decision shall be final.
7. Any competitor wishing to lodge a protest must adopt the following procedure:
 - a. Protests relating to the days fishing must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Protest Committee before 19.00 that day.
 - b. Protests relating to the results must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Protest Committee before 08.00 the following day.
8. Wire line is prohibited except for traces, if that is the competitor's choice.
9. Competitors may only have one rod fitted with terminal tackle at any one time. A second rod and reel may be assembled but without terminal tackle attached.
10. This is a two hook competition.
11. Foul hooked fish do not count. Fish to be hooked forward of the furthest gill cover. Any fish hooked by more than one angler is automatically disqualified and must be returned to the water.
12. Each competitor is responsible for measuring and having their score witnessed before acknowledging their catch with the score recorder. At the end of fishing all competitors shall sign that their catch record is correct. Under **NO** circumstances can scores be changed or fish added to the score sheet.
13. Anglers may only receive assistance to net or gaff a fish.
14. Boats must fish at anchor.
15. Casting is allowed so long as the terminal tackle is cast from outside the boat and does not impede other anglers.

16. Anglers must return their catch to the water before fishing can recommence. If a fish is retained for consumption or record purposes, then it must be recorded and killed before fishing can recommence.
17. When the skipper/captain states lines up at the end of days fishing then lines should be retrieved as quickly as possible, should an angler have a fish on then they must clearly shout this to the boat captain. Should the boat need to move during the allocated fishing time the boat skipper/captain will call lines up, then all Anglers must retrieve their lines as quickly as possible and only return them to the water on the instruction of the boat skipper/captain. There are no exceptions to this rule.
18. Bait is supplied (Mackerel & Squid). Only the bait provided or bait caught by the angler can be used.
19. After 3 hrs fishing, anglers will have 10 minutes to move round the boat i.e. stern positions will move to bow. This will be clearly identified on each boat.
20. Correct dress will be worn at the prize giving ceremony; this is considered to be International/Section Uniform or smart casual wear (to include a tie). **No denims, jeans, tee shirts or trainers.** Competitors attending the prize ceremony in improper dress will forfeit their right to have their prize presented in public.

Scoring System.

- A. Bream of 30cms and above will be eligible to score points, based on 1 point for each complete cm. of length all measurements are to be rounded up on fish over 30cm. Your top 10 longest bream will count and will be added together to give a total combined length each day.
- B. The angler's overall placing will be decided by their combined points score over the two days, the Angler with the most points being declared the winner. In the event of a tie on points the angler recording the Longest fish shall prevail.

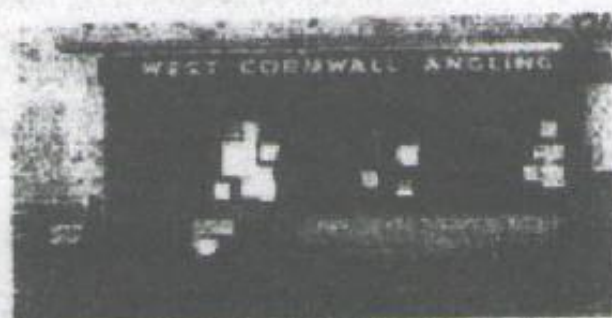

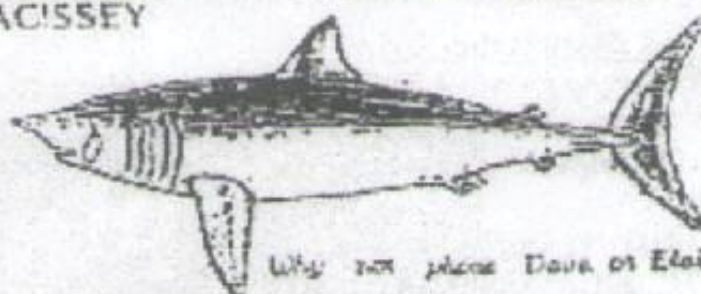
