Further regulations have now been set by the European Union which will take effect from January 1st, 2016

Between Jan 1st and June 30th NO BASS may be retained by the recreational Sea Angler.

Between July 1st and December 31st only ONE BASS per day may be retained by the recreational sea angler .

Please note that the minimum size for retaining Bass is now 42cm.

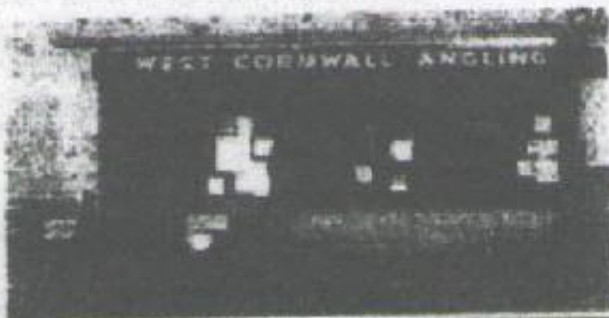
