The first leg was fished on Sunday 24th April with the CAA recording 779.417% and the MBAS recording 590.883%, a lead of 188.58% for the CAA to take into the second leg which was fished on Sunday 22nd May.

On the day the MBAs recorded 413.792% and the CAA recorded 604.238%.

Overall winners were the CAA by a margin of 378.98%, thus winning back the Tre-Pol-Pen trophy.

All qualifiers for the final have been notified and can weigh their fish in with their pre-nominated club Recorder.

CFSA Fish Returns

On fish weighed with your Club Recorder in respect of returns for a Federation competition, it would be beneficial if those fish were put on a separate monthly return stating what competition the fish were entered for.

Please note, record fish or 100% fish which have been notified to the CFSA Recorder within the 24/48 hour period respectively still have to be included with the end of the month returns.

Shark, Tope and SmoothHounds formula

The girth is taken at the deepest point of the body and the length is measured from the nose to the fork of the tail.

Shark, Tope and SmoothHound

Example

Fishes girth = 26in

Fishes length = 55in

26 x 26 = 676

676 x 55 = 37180

37180 divided by 800 = 46.475lb

The formula can be used for the recording of specimen fish only, the captor must have a witness. The formula applies to both Boat and Shore caught fish, remember Tope and Shark caught either from the Boat or the Shore must be returned unharmed.

The Peter Bottono Memorial Trophy

A reminder that this Trophy is available to be won in 2016 and is awarded for the best specimen from a Junior, Boat or Shore, caught in the river Fal which the boundary line is from Pendennis point and Zone point.


