**Peaceful demo in opposition to the ending of a public right to catch and keep a Bass whilst commercial gill netters are allowed to continue catching and selling Bass and have had their monthly limit increased.**

The objective for this demo is to attract media coverage of Cornish sea angler's total opposition to being prevented from keeping a Bass whilst commercial fishing, which is a primary cause of stock depletion, continues.

All R.S.A.'s who wish to come on the demo should meet at Rosewarne car park, Camborne at 9.30am on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> April.

At 10.00am we will march to the constituency office of Mr George Eustice MP who is also the Fisheries Minister.

Banners brought for the march can have the suggested following messages on them:

"Priority for hook & line fishing". "Bass are a public resource". "End all netting in estuaries and close to shore". "Sea angling equals economic impacts and jobs".

The protest will finish at 11.00am and is for ALL sea anglers regardless of whether they are members of any angling organisations or not.

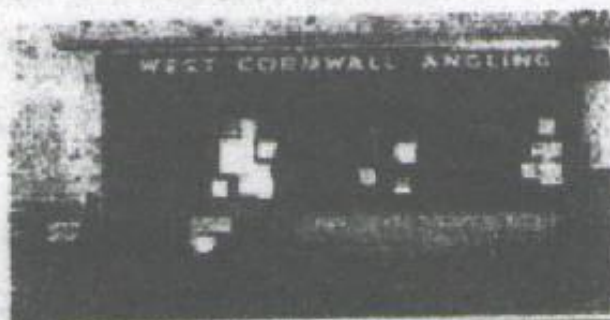

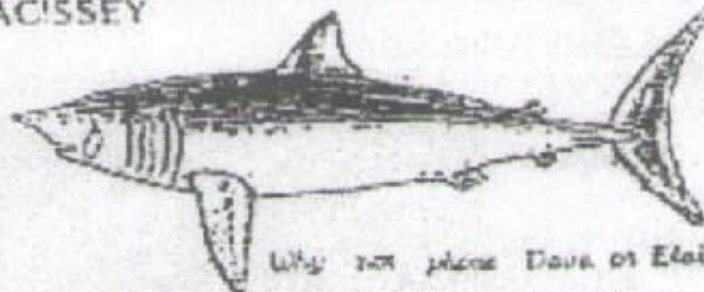
