The meeting voted in favour of the following three proposals

1. A catch and release policy will commence in 2017 for all Boat and Shore caught Bull Huss and all species of Ray. All fish to be photographed and measured and returned to the sea unharmed.
If accepted, the policy would be in force as a trial for two years before any other species would be considered for catch and release.
2. **IF** it comes into force in 2017 that Bass will not be allowed to be retained by commercial fishermen, the Executive have no problem with the catch and release policy as in place at present for the first six months of the year to be extended to twelve months.
3. A maximum of three rods and three hooks be used whilst pleasure fishing and also in Comps run under CFSA rules. At present any record fish caught whilst pleasure fishing with three rods would not count under present CFSA rules as all CFSA records and comps must be fished using two rods and three hooks.
