Reminder - rule 14 Specimen Fish - Annual Awards D5

Any fish weighed and submitted to the Federation with a specimen weight of 1lb or under from either Boat or Shore is to be awarded a maximum of 75%. If the weight of these fish exceeds 1lb then the percentage awarded is to be calculated against the Cornish record for that species.

A reminder that this rule was deleted at the 6th May 2004 EGM and the reason was because the Federation already has a specimen fish list.

Reminder- Rule 20(e) at all competitions run under CFSA Rules

All winning fish must be put on display at least five minutes before the winners are announced so that any objections can be made to the organising committee on payment of £1 by the objector. This is returned if the objection is deemed reasonable, the decision of the organising committee being final.

Fish may not be removed from the table until all prizes have been awarded.

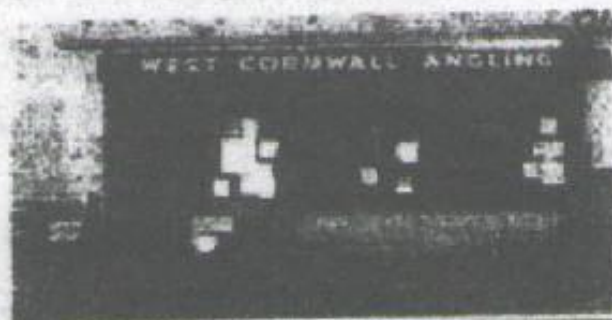
