#### A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Hi All and welcome to the BCC newsletter for 2022.

I hope you all had a great Christmas and happy new year.

2022 was a definite improvement compared to the Covid ravaged previous years, the only down side being the high winds.

Global warming is dismissed by some, but I can't remember having a year when so many fishing trips were cancelled due to winds, I hope this year will be calmer.

The 2022 members comp went ahead successfully, it had it's issues, most of which were discussed by the committee in ensuing meetings and the proposed solutions are listed below.

1) There seemed to be doubt from some that a minutes silence was held for members who had passed in the previous year. Others had heard it announced, but maybe due to the background noise hadn't taken it on board.

This is a difficult one to address in a club room we are sharing with non BCC members and all the subsequent noise, Mick has said he will ask the clubs committee to turn down any music/TV during the next AGM. Although I sincerely hope the minutes silence will not be needed in 2023.


- 2) The biggest cause of angst at the meeting was the introduction of 60lb minimum braid as a main line. This caused so much friction we have decided to make this a recommendation rather than a rule. However using mono as a main line will still be outlawed and for the safety of the skippers unhooking and netting eels a rubbing leader of suitable strength will still be required.
- 3) The comp was won by two anglers with identical weight eels, this is the first time it has ever happened and although both anglers names will be on the trophy, first prize was only given to one of them. We all deemed this unfair. To address this we worked out the difference in cost between 1st and 2nd prize this equated to the cost of entry to this year's comp with the rollover. Kev Lindup who received the 2nd prize has accepted this as recompense and as such will enter this year's comp for free.
- 4) There were some allegations that the boat draw was unfair and as a result it was decided to do the boat draw on the Friday night at the AGM. In order to facilitate this we have asked that members only put down to fish with one other person.
- 5) There was an incident on board one of the boats where an angler was hit by another anglers lead, I wasn't witness to this and believe the other angler apologised profusely.




All terminal gear will be outside of the boat before being released into the water.

I'm happy to say that the vacant post has been filled by John Bellamy. Welcome aboard John.




#### RECORDS FROM THE RECORDS OFFICER / TROPHIES AND AWARDS FOR 2022:



Overall in 2022 I recorded eleven eels, 55lb and over. The 2022 Interport was won by Kevin Turner and Paul Cashmore with a total weight of 141lbs 14oz. The largest ling caught was 27lb 8oz by Sam James and the heaviest eel caught single handed was 36lb 12oz by Steve Holyer.

N.b. an oversight of the committee during the 2022 BCC Festival awards evening meant that Robin Amor and Paul Maris were not presented with the Angling Magazine, Sea Angler Trophy, Electric Blue trophies and Saltwind trophy respectively. Many Apologies to both these members.






## TREASURER'S REPORT

Special thanks go also to Weymouth Angling club for their hospitality, letting us use their club as our new HQ.







#### **COMPETITIONS AND TROPHIES**

<u>Interport Competition:</u> This annual competition for teams of two runs from 1 June to 30 September and is very simple to enter. All you need to do is inform our **Records Officer David Lee** before your day of fishing and provide the following details:

- Names of both anglers
- Fishing date
- Boat name and port to be fished from

After the trip all you need to do is let the Records Officer know the weights of your individual best eels. Only one entry per year is allowed for this competition, but if your trip is cancelled you can let the Records Officer know and retry another time.

<u>Shore Competition:</u> This competition runs from 1 October to 30 November. You can fish anywhere from the shore at any time during this period and send in your entry in the usual way but make sure you ask for the fish to be entered into the Shore Competition.

<u>Geoff Flores Bronze Trophy:</u> This trophy is awarded annually to the BCC member who catches and releases the highest number of Conger Eels over the given year.

An entry form is attached at the end of this newsletter. Complete this and send to **Records Officer** at the end of the year.

<u>Thompson Medal Awards:</u> These are awarded annually to paid up Members for capture of Conger Eels in the following weight categories:

## Boat Captured Shore Captured

55lbs and over – Bronze	25lbs and over – Bronze
65lbs and over - Silver	35lbs and over – Silver
75lbs and over – Gold	45lbs and over – Gold


You can win only one of these a year. If you are fortunate enough to catch more than one medal category fish, you will receive the appropriate medal for your best eel. You will need to supply capture details and photographic evidence to **Records Officer** to be eligible. To supply details you will need to complete one of the club's Specimen Fish Entry forms.
